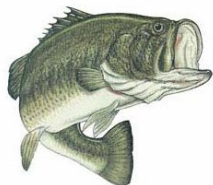

HCBM OPEN TOURNAMENT RULES

1. Our tournaments are open to all persons to fish as a team, providing the person operating the combustion engine is 18 years of age or older. An adult choosing a minor as a partner will take full responsibility for that minor.
2. Entry fees must be paid prior to the pre-tournament meeting. There will be no entry fee refunds.
3. A pre-tournament meeting will immediately follow registration. At least one member of the team **MUST** be in attendance at this meeting.
4. **Largemouth, Smallmouth and Kentucky Spotted Bass will be the only kind of fish weighed in. INDIANA REGULATIONS: 14 INCH LIMIT ON LAKE WAELAND. ALL FISH WILL BE MEASURED ON THE GOLDEN RULE. THERE IS A FIVE FISH LIMIT PER TEAM.**
5. There shall be no alcoholic beverages or illegal substances before or during tournament hours or during weigh-in. All competitors are expected to show courtesy to other competitors and non-competitors alike.
6. Tournament boats shall not cut in front of another boater at a distance of less than 50 yards.
7. Boaters are expected to meet coast guards requirements as to boat equipment and horse power specifications. Motors must have a kill switch. It is required that each boat have an adequate live well to maintain two limits of bass.
8. All participants must wear life jackets with the kill switch attached whenever the big motor is running (not the trolling motor).
9. Competitors who are not in the official check point area by the designated time shall be penalized at the rate of 1 pound per minute, to be deducted from the total weight to be counted that day, including any weight toward a lunker award. Any competitor more than 15 minutes late loses all credit for that day.
10. **FOR EACH LEGAL SIZE BASS WEIGHED IN DEAD A ONE POUND PENALTY SHALL BE DEDUCTED FROM THE WEIGHT OF THAT FISH. THE TOURNAMENT DIRECTOR AND THE COMMITTEE SHALL HAVE THE AUTHORITY TO DETERMINE A DEAD FISH.**
11. No live or natural baits except pork and dry rind baits may be used.
12. No trolling allowed and only one (1) rod may be used at one time.
13. All fishing must be done from the boat.
14. In the event of a tie, money will be equally divided between those places involved.
15. All protest of rule violation(s) shall be submitted in writing within fifteen (15) minutes of the tournament completion and handed to the tournament director. This must be done prior to the completion of the final weight-in.
16. Decisions by the tournament director will be made at the site and shall be final.
17. All participants will be notified of any change via email. If an email address is not supplied with the entry form, it will be the responsibility of the participants to check the website www.hendrickscoutybassmasters.com for tournament updates or changes.
